Raabe, Burdick, Broedel, Raabe, Harris and Gilbert Take Thunder Alley Wins

Evans Mills NY... Caprara's Thunder Alley Speed Park presented a full night of racing action on Saturday, June 06, 2009. In action were the DIRTcar Sportsman, DIRTcar Street Stocks, DIRTcar Crate Late Models, IMCA Modifieds, Purestocks, and Mod Lites.

The DIRTcar Sportsman would kick off the nights feature racing action with Jeff Rowe and Christine Martin with Jeff Rowe taking the early lead on the field. Chris Raabe and Brandon Sweet quickly moved into the second and third positions as they began to track down Jeff Rowe. By lap six, Brandon Sweet would lead the field with Chris Raabe to the outside of him. Chris Raabe would power around Brandon Sweet going into turn one and two to take over the lead on the field while Jeff Rowe and Christine Martin filled out the top three. When the checkered flag dropped, Chris Raabe would take the win over Brandon Sweet and Jeff Rowe.

Richard Stone and Todd Raabe would lead the Street Stocks to green with Raabe jumping out to take the early command while the rest of the field battled side by side for position. By lap four, Dave Pope would slide under Todd Raabe and attempt to take the lead as the field would come to the caution flag. When racing would resume, Todd Raabe would continue to lead the field while Keith Doxtater would come up on his rear bumper and the two would battle for position. As the checkered flag would wave, Todd Raabe would collect the win over Keith Doxtater and Mike White.

Chris Thurston and Brian Holder would lead the IMCA feature to green with Chris Thurston taking the early control. JJ Courcy would fill up the second position with Ryan Scott taking over position number three. On lap eight, Ryan Scott would move around JJ Courcy to look to take the second position and also challenge for the lead. While running three wide, JJ Courcy would hit a tire coming out of turn two which would put Ryan Scott right on the back bumper of Chris Thurston as the field would go green. As the checkered flag would wave, Chris Thurston would collect the win over Ryan Scott and Larry Bezner.

John Williams and Alan Jackson would lead the Thunder Car feature to the green flag. John Williams would take the early lead with Matt Marcinko and Robert Scott leading the field as they completed lap number one. By lap five, Matt Marcinko would be at the front of the field riding around the top part of the speedway while Robert Martin was a half a car length behind him challenging for the second position. On lap ten, Eli Gilbert would put his car at the front of the field and challenge Matt Marcinko for the lead while positions three, four and five would battle side by side. On lap 13, Eli Gilbert would move under Matt Marcinko to take over the lead of the field. When the checkered flag dropped, Eli Gilbert would collect the win while Robert Scott and Zak Petrie would complete the top three.

Charles Oliver and Matt Rainville would lead the Mod Lites to their features green flag with Bruce Broedel jumping out from the sixth place position to take the lead coming to complete lap one. By lap five, Rich Rainville would take over the lead on the field with Jason Broedel and Jeff Barker rounding out the top three.. Jason Broedel would waste no time as he

moved around Rainville to take over the command of the field while Bruce Broedel and Rich Rainville would battle behind him. As the checkered waved, Jason Broedel would take the win while Rich Rainville and Bruce Broedel would complete the top three.

Mike Blair and Kevin Smith would lead the Purestocks to green with Mike Blair taking the early lead. Blair would keep control of the field as the field would approach half way. Al Harris would control the second position while Kevin Smith would have third. When the checkered flag was dropped, Al Harris would pick up the win while Mike Blair and Kevin Smith would complete the top three.

Racing action will continue on Saturday, June 13, 2009 with regular racing action.
