Raabe, Courcy, Broedel, Doxtater and Martin Take Thunder Alley Wins

Evans Mills NY... Thunder Alley Speed Park hosted a regular night of racing on Saturday June 27, 2009. In action were the DIRTcar Sportsman, DIRTcar Street Stocks, IMCA Modifieds, Mod Lites, Purestocks and Thunder Cars.

Terry Gould and Rick McCready would lead the Sportsman to the green with Rick McCready taking the early command. Christine Martin would fill up the second position while Ken Bearup would settle in third. Chris Raabe would power to the outside of Christine Martin to take over the second position while Martin would hold onto third. On a lap nine restart, Chris Raabe would power to the outside of McCready to take over the lead while Jeff Rowe would tip toe to the bottom and control the second position. As the checkered flag dropped, Chris Raabe would collect the win over Jeff Rowe and Rick McCready.

Shawn Kirby and Dale Jewett would command the front row in the IMCA division as they took to the green in their 15 lap feature event. Shawn Kirby would take the initial control of the field while Brian Holder and Larry Bezner would battle side by side for the second position. JJ Courcy made a mad dash to the front of the field as by lap 7, he found himself in the third position after starting last on the field. JJ Courcy would move around the bottom of the speedway and take the lead by lap nine while the rest of the field battled for position. JJ Courcy would go on to collect the win over Ryan Scott and Brian Holder.

Richard Stone and Keith Doxtater would lead the DIRTcar Street Stocks to green in their 15 lap feature event.. Keith Doxtater would use the outside to his advantage to take over the control of the field. Taylor Caprara used the outside to power around Richard Stone to take the second position while Todd Raabe followed in suite by taking position number three. The top three would stay nose to tail while Dave Pope worked under Richard Stone for fourth. When the checkered flag flew, Keith Doxtater would take the win over Taylor Caprara and Todd Raabe.

Charles Oliver and Bryan Green led the Mod Lite feature to green with Bryan Green jumping out to the early lead. By lap three, Bruce Broedel would move under Bryan Green to take the lead while Rich Rainville slipped into second. Jason Broedel would move under Rich Rainville to take over the second position. Bruce Broedel would battle side by side with Jason Broedel for the lead while Rich Rainville would fill out third and Matt Rainville would be in fourth. As the checkered waved, Bruce Broedel would take the win over Jason Broedel and Rich Rainville.

Alan Jackson and Matt Marcinko would lead the Thunder Cars to green with Matt Marcinko taking the command of the field. Dan Way would quickly move into the second position while Eli Gilbert would take position number three. Robert Martin would slide to the front of the field by lap seven with Matt Marcinko and Robert Scott closely following behind him. Robert Martin would take the victory in the race shortened feature due to rain.

The purestock feature was unable to get their feature in and will start off racing action on Saturday, July 11th. Racing at Thunder Alley will resume on Saturday, July 11, 2009 as racing

action will not take place on July 4th due to racing activities at Caprara's Can-Am Motorsports Park.
